

A Team

- The A team will be composed of the following leadership:
 - a. 1 Captain of Building
 - b. 1 Captain of Programming
 - c. 1 CIT (Captain In Training) who is in charge of Online Challenges
- The A team Captains will be elected in a 51% passing vote per position.
- A Team CIT
 - a. The A team CIT must:
 - i. Have at least 1-year experience
 - ii. Be a non-senior in the year that they will be the CIT
 - iii. Have shown up to at least 75% of the meetings in the year before they will be the CIT
 - iv. Be a diligent, hard-working member of the team
 - b. The A team CIT will be nominated by the captains and will be confirmed by a 51% passing vote of the rest of the team.
- A Team Attendance Policy
 - a. A team members will be required to attend at least 2 meetings per week of meetings

V Team

- The V team will be composed of the following leadership:
 - a. 1 Captain of Building
 - b. 1 Captain of Programming
- V Team Attendance Policy
 - a. V team members will be required to attend at least 2 meetings per week of meetings

Non Team Specifics

→ Rule Infractions

- a. 1st rule infraction by a team member will be issued a warning
- b. 2nd rule infraction by a team member will be issued a second and final warning
- c. 3rd rule infraction by a team member will result in a meeting with the respective teams' leadership to determine the repercussion(s). The repercussion(s) will be up to the discretion of the respective teams' leadership
- d. 4th and any further rule infraction by a team member will result in a meeting with both team's leadership to determine the repercussions(s). The repercussion(s) will be up to both team's leadership.
- e. If any team member on either team does anything illegal, violates any PUSD policies, and / or physically hurts someone they may and will be kicked off the team for the remainder of the school year with no notice.

→ Administration

- a. All purchases will be approved by a 75% passing vote of the A and V team leadership.
- b. The A and V team leadership may demote and move anyone from any team with a 1-day notice.
- c. The A team leadership may modify the requirements to apply for the A team at any time without notice.
- d. The team policies may be modified at any time with a 75% passing vote of all team's leadership.
- e. Violation of a teams' attendance policy will and may be a rule infraction
- f. Excused attendance policy violation(s) are up to the discretion of the respective teams' leadership
- g. To run for either of the teams' leadership a team member must complete 1 or year of active participation on the team that they are running for leadership on, or have been a captain in the last year
- h. To run for either of the teams' leadership a team member must have attended at least 75% of the prior year's meetings

→ Team member conduct

- a. Any transportation to, from, and during an event that a team member is attending is to be conducted in a manner that does not violate any laws and does not endanger the safety of others.
