Letter to Parents from Avengineers Leadership:

Thank you for supporting your child's participation in the Vex Robotics Competition (VRC) program. This program allows your child to have fun and learn about robotics, engineering, and teamwork in a team-oriented learning environment under adult supervision. The VRC program is not just here at Amador Valley High School, but is a worldwide program with participants from many different countries. This program exists to help solve the "STEM Problem". The "STEM Problem" is the idea that the development of innovation will stagnate as a result of not enough people in STEM related fields. Each year as a team, we build and program a robot from scratch using the Vex Robotics EDR product line. Using this robot, we compete in tournament events to get to the world competition held in the US each year. The competition game of the VRC program changes each year. This year the game is called "Spin Up" where the robot we build will have to manipulate discs into goals. The robot will also have operate both manually and autonomously. Additionally, the team also hosts an annual VRC competition featuring teams from all over the Northern California region. This event consists of organizing, planning and running the competition. The competition gives our team members an opportunity to volunteer to help make the event successful and an enjoyable experience for the participants.
